We should have confirming news after the December 17th meeting of City Council.

Reluctantly, beginning in January, we will be increasing the cost of coffee to \$1.25 for a bottomless cup. Pie will be \$3.50 a slice, with whipped cream for 50 cents, and a single scoop of ice cream will also be 50 cents. Muffins will be \$2.50, with Sam's special butter tart muffins selling for \$3.00.
