

CAMPBELL RIVER SENIORS' CENTRE SOCIETY

CONSTITUTION

1. The name of the society is Campbell River Seniors' Centre Society.
2. The purposes of the Society are:
 - a. To provide a place for senior citizens who are members to meet and enjoy the companionship of others
 - b. To provide facilities for recreation and other activities of interest to the members.
 - c. To encourage the seniors to actively participate in the programs provided by the Society and to contribute their ideas
 - d. To do everything incidental and necessary to obtain the foregoing purposes.
3. The purposes and activities of the Society shall be based in the City of Campbell River.
4. The Society will be carried on without purpose of gain for the members and any profits of other accretions to the Society shall be used for promoting the purposes.
5. In the event that at any time the Society should be dissolved, the remaining assets shall be turned over to a recognized charitable organization in the province or elsewhere in Canada as directed by its members.

Clauses 4 and 5 and this article are unalterable in accordance with Section 17 of the Societies Act
