- We are still looking for Musicians. We would like to start a Tuesday afternoon Jam from 1:00 to 3:00. Please pass on the message if you know someone.

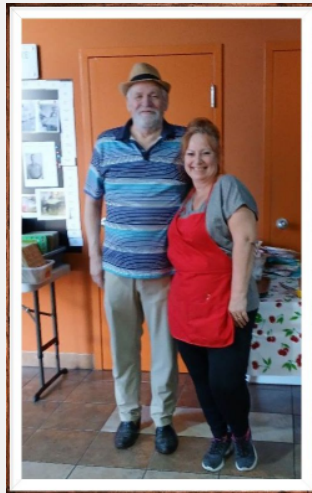
